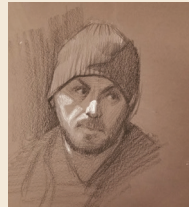


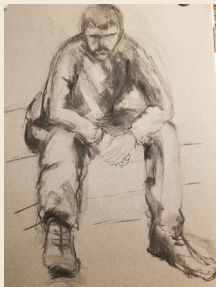

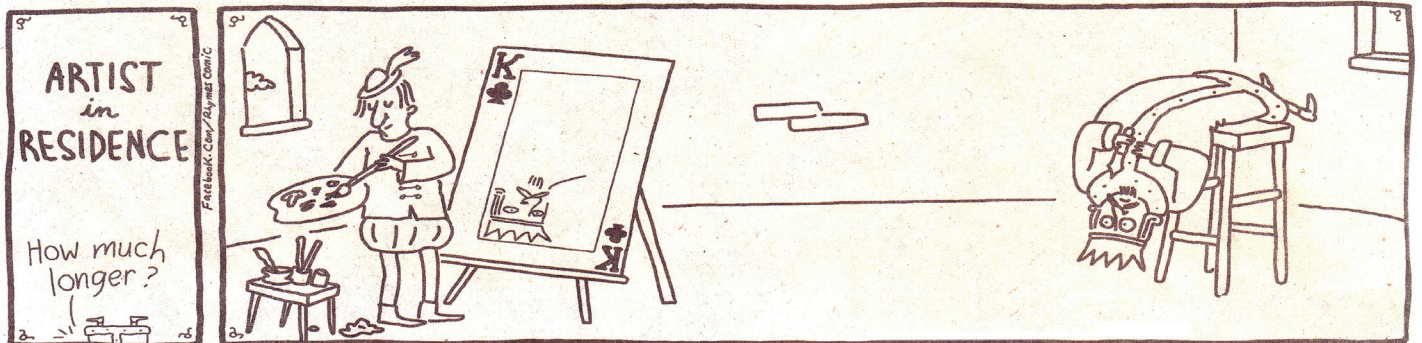
Check out just a few of the many things happening in the Exchange for First Fridays (March 6)!
