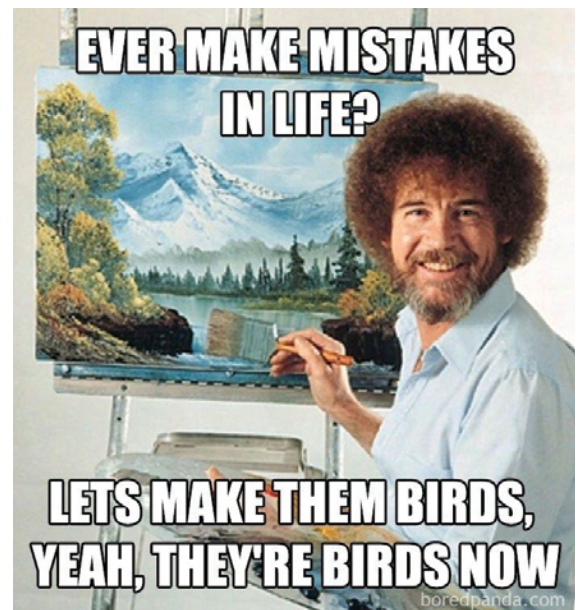

## Photographing Your Work

For your work to be seen in the best light for jurying, you should ensure that:

1. The artwork is not distorted
2. The entire image is in focus
3. The colour looks accurate
4. The lighting is even across the surface
