Communication

We use a variety of communication tools throughout the school year. A newsletter will be sent home at the beginning of each month to update you on school events, dates, and important information. Please take the time to read it, as many important reminders are communicated this way.

In addition, emails are frequently used to send notes and school event information. Our school's Facebook Page is used to post reminders and resources.

If you need to get a hold of someone at school or have a time sensitive message, please call the front desk.

Some of our staff members accept text messages as a form of communication. As these are personal devices, we ask that you are mindful of the hours you send messages. (Please send messages between 8 am – 4 pm, weekdays only. Thank you.)

Bright Arrow

An automated messaging system called Bright Arrow will be used to communicate time sensitive information regarding school closures, bus changes or bus cancellations.

Cancellations & Closures

We do our best to provide prompt notice when or if we are to have an emergency school closure or bus cancellations during power outages or extreme weather. Please keep in mind, permission to cancel school is granted by the Area 3 Office.

Assessment Days

This year Frontier School Division has once again implemented two assessment days at the beginning of the year, to provide teachers with valuable time to meet with each student and carry out literacy and numeracy assessments before the school year takes off.

These assessment days are scheduled for Monday, September 18th and Tuesday, September 19th.

What this means is:

- There will be no regular classes on these two days
- Students will be assigned a timeslot to attend school and meet with their teacher for a brief period of 1:1 time, that will allow teachers to get to know their students and needs
- Parents will be asked to drop off their child and pick them up at the end of their designated time period
- Mrs. Turner will be reaching out to you to communicate your child's scheduled time during the first week of school

<u>Leaving School Grounds for Lunch</u>

Students in grades **7/8/9/10** are permitted to leave the school grounds at lunch time from 12:00 – 12:40 with the permission of their parents. If you would like this option for your child, please send a written note to school, granting permission for your child to leave the property at noon hour. Please bare in mind, this is a privilege, that will be granted providing students are able to return to school on time for afternoon classes and act responsibly. Students in younger grades will not be permitted to leave school grounds for lunch unless they are met by a parent/guardian.



Healthy Food & Pop Free School

We ask that parents send children to school with a reusable Water Bottle, so they are able to make use of our two new water bottle fill stations throughout the day. In addition, we are a proudly POP FREE school. Please do not send pop to school with your children for lunches or snacks.



Dropping Off Young Children

Parents who choose to drop off young children at school are asked to please accompany them on to the school grounds and ensure they have touched base with the teacher out on recess duty, so we know your child has arrived at school and take over supervision of them.
